CASE STUDY: LEVERAGING AUTONOMOUS OPERATIONS

Since our autonomy journey began in 2012, Thiess has combined leading-edge insight with our extensive operational experience to provide a range of autonomous services.

In 2023, Thiess began mining operations at the new Olive Downs Complex in Queensland with 21 autonomous haul trucks and three autonomous drills. It represents a significant milestone for the Olive Downs Complex to deploy both Cat® MineStarTM Command for hauling and Command for drilling – Caterpillar's autonomous hauling and drilling solutions.

In 2024, Thiess join forces with WesTrac and Caterpillar® to hit a one million meter autonomous drilling milestone at Mt Arthur South. Since introducing autonomy at Mt Arthur South in 2021, Thiess has recorded a 20 per cent improvement in drilling performance, up to eight per cent reduction in fuel use, more consistent drill hole quality, accuracy and depth, and drill utilization of up to 23 hours per day.
